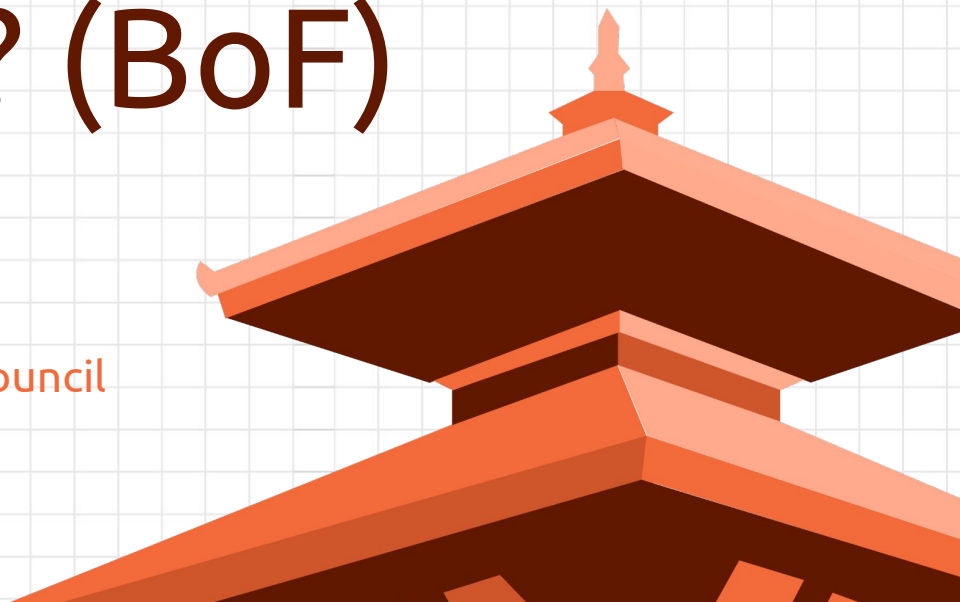

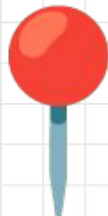

Conference contents

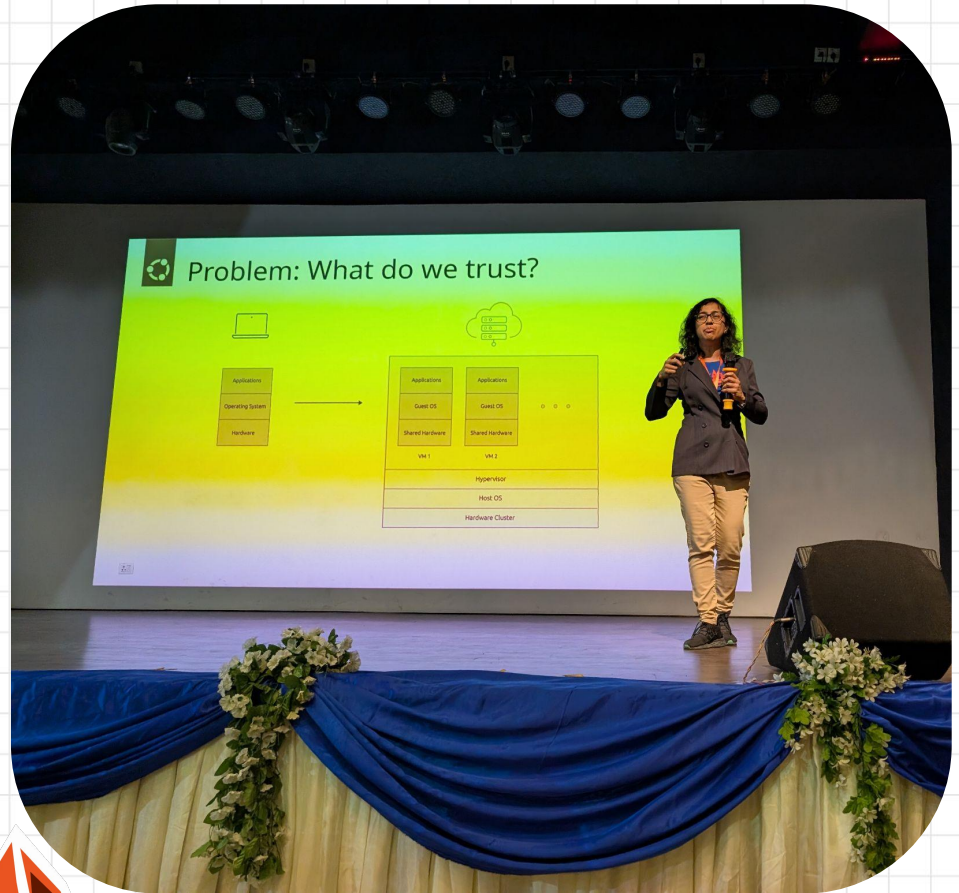
- **Talks (or Lectures):** 20 min ~ 50 min

- **Exhibitions**



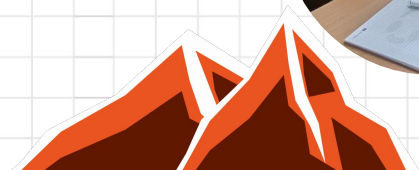

Event dates & Scale

- Late Q3 or Early Q4
- Conference 2 days, Day trip 1 day
- 300+ Participants
- 1 Main hall, 1 hall for talks, 1 room for workshops, 1-2 spare rooms, reception, exhibition space
- Recommended to put all rooms in same building and same floor



Submitting your bid

Simple explanation: Write bid based on the bid template then publish that on Ubuntu Discourse

Long explanation:

- Build your initial team and plan, find venue
- Make sure you can post on Ubuntu Discourse
- Create new bid posting from the template
- Fill up bunch of sections (good luck)
- Post it, then also reply on bid announcement thread with link to your post.



Bid schedule

Submission deadline

- 2026: Passed 5+ month. Rolling basis now
- 2027: End of Q1 2026 (or early Q2) - TBD

What we do after the deadline

- Review & feedback - We may ask you to update bid document
- Quick presentation on video call with Q&A
- Committee Votes, Decides then announce
