- More focus on local communities (LoCo)























### Organizing Ubucon





#### Organizing: Make overall plan

- Build a team You can't make it alone!
- When Dates
- Where Venue
- How many sessions and attendees
- Timelines





#### Organizing: First things to do

- Find and Acquire a venue Earlier better!
  - You should also consider infrastructures nearby!: Metro,
     Restaurants, Banquets, Hotels, etc.
- Get quotations and make budget plans
- Find fiscal host (or legal partner)
  - Who will manage funds, tax, issue invoice, sign on sponsorship contract and receive funds from sponsors.





#### Call for proposals and sponsors

- Call for proposals
  - Stress during CFP periods
    - Not enough proposal even with promoting hard
    - Duplicates, Spams, Too long abstracts
- Call for sponsors
  - Marketing team usually sponsors event and their sponsorship budgets are limited. - early contact better for sponsorship.
  - Sponsors or attendees? Who's more important?
    - No sponsors, no budget. No attendees, no event.
  - Sending sponsorship proposal mail is like spreading resume via mail for getting a first job.





#### Selecting proposals and scheduling


- Slots are always limited due to time and physical spaces.
  - You need to drop some proposals even it's good one.
  - Not every session can be assigned on main hall.
- Inviting speakers in-person
  - Providing hotels and flights If they need support
  - Visas (on next page...)



- Event manager (pretalx, eventyay...)
- Social networks
- Payments (for paid tickets)
  - Asia: 2 Seperate event platform due to payment regulation in South Korea

#### Post Ubucon tasks

- Editing/publishing photos/videos
- Publishing numbers and statistics
- Choosing next location
  - o provide help and resources
- Close accounting & Managing remaining funds
  - Receive post-event sponsorship funds. and pay balance.
    - Hotels, venue usually allow organizer to pay 10% contract fee first and pay balance after event.
    - Check if any financial loss
  - Keep remaining funds for next event
  - Donate





# Some advices for next Ubucon organizers

- Start organizing earlier!
- Ask for help, don't be shy
- Reuse!
- Sometimes, you need to say "No"
